Application:

Sedum cuttings are the most economical method for planting vegetation on a green roof. DIAAlbum is a mix of six or more sedum species. Green roofs tend toward extreme conditions, each species has been selected to tolerate different rooftop microclimates. Sedum cuttings are typically used on large extensive type green roofs, and can be used alone or in combination with plugs and/or seeds.

Installation instructions:

- Diadem Sedum Cuttings shall be installed by qualified contractors with demonstrated experience and project references. Fall is the best time to plant, allowing cuttings to begin establishment prior to the onset of Winter. The cuttings shall be installed in such a manner as to not damage or disturb any previously installed roofing components. ***
- Thoroughly moisten growing medium prior to distributing cuttings.
- Pre-mix cuttings by hand to ensure the random distribution of sedum varieties.
- Cuttings shall be hand broadcast over wet soil at the rate specified.
- Distribute varieties as shown on landscape plan. Newly installed cuttings shall be immediately and thoroughly watered. It is recommended to have overhead irrigation in place until the vegetation is established. Automatic overhead irrigation is preferred.
