Application:

The ADZ fencing is suitable for cordoning off areas with different function, without penetrating the roof membrane, and yet offering perfect drainage underneath. The system can be used for roof edge fall prevention, walkway demarcation, stairwells, open elevator shaft fall protection, skylight fall protection, and fulfillment of other prescribed safety requirements.

Installation instructions:

The System must be installed onto a sealant-protected surface. The system's modular components allow installation of a 600 foot run by 2 people in 8 hours, saving you time and money where it counts most - on site. First place the heavy duty MDE 60 drainage boards along the line of the planned fence and fill cavities with pumice. Next, measure and mark the distance between posts. The post supporting plates can now be attached with several rivets to the MDE boards. The rivet holes should be pre-drilled. The fence posts should be bolted into position without tightening the nuts. The fencing panels can be bolted onto the posts at this stage. Only after making the finer adjustments to the system should the bolts be finally tightened.
